### Fundraising

#### Fees and Fundraising

The cost of running a baseball program can be substantial. To help make it affordable for all families, the membership fees have been kept reasonable. This fee helps to cover some of the costs associated with the season (tournament fees, equipment, field fees, umpire fees, etc.), but it does not cover some costs. This means we also need to have a method of fundraising. The methods we use will never violate our Statement of Faith and will always support our Christian purpose as we work together to acquire the funds necessary to make this one of the very best homeschool baseball programs in the South East.

#### Membership Fees

There is a per player membership fee for each level of the program. For junior varsity players this is \$450. For varsity players it is \$600 per player.

### Fundraising

Each player on a regular team is required to participate in CSRA Crusaders fundraisers to help fund the regular season.

Fundraising events include, but are not limited to:

Events sponsored by the Fundraising committee – Participation is mandatory.

These events may include food concessions at local community events, car washes, or actions deemed worthy by the Fundraising committee.

### Exceptions

Any player who does not wish to participate in the fundraising may pay an “opt out” fee of \$200 for junior varsity and middle school or \$300 for varsity.
